- While the notes are helpful reminders the most value this class has is with the instructors and how they deliver the information

**How have you benefited from the Supervision Program?**

- I have started to see a positive reaction from my reports that I can attribute to the classes; taking the lessons and employing them have made me a better leader

- A greater understanding from a personal standpoint; understanding the decisions that are made and how it affects me and my crew
