

WSU has NEW parking regulations effective 9-1-2016.



The new regulations for WSU instruct that every visitor on campus, once they are parked must register online with the Shocker Parking Management System by signing into an electronic parking system (can be done on an app on a smart phone), register their vehicle and tag number, and pay a \$5 fee to park on campus for the day.

The University Police will use license plate recognition (LPR) technology that will read everyone's license plate, and issue parking tickets (or warnings) to visitors when they are not registered into the ePermit system. Every plate number will get three (3) warnings and then a \$25 ticket will be issued to the owner of the plate. ePermits are required from 7 a.m.- 5 p.m. Monday through Friday in **yellow, green** and **yellow-and-green**-striped lots. **Red, orange** and **brown** lots, as well as RED reserved spaces, and handicapped spaces are reserved at all times.

There is a 2 hour grace period, so if you are on campus less than 2 hours, you do not need a permit to park. Since the monitoring stops at 5 p.m., if you are coming to CMD for a 4:30 p.m. class, you do not need a permit to park.

For today, since you are not registered in the ePermit system, you may get a warning – not a ticket - on your windshield when you go to leave for the day.

Going forward, it is our intent, that CMD take care of your visitor registration, saving you hassle and any fees. The plan is to get the information needed to register your vehicle when you register for the class. CMD will, the morning of your training, register your car for you and take care of the fee. If the vehicle information hasn't been collected at the time of registration for the class, you can provide that information to us the morning you arrive, and we will get your vehicle registered. It is our intent to make your day as hassle free as possible.

Please be aware that if you are coming for a multiple day class, and your vehicle isn't registered each day, you will receive three warnings and then a ticket. Also, many of you attend 2, 3 or 4 CMD sessions each year, as you complete certificate programs. Each day on campus your vehicle must be registered.

Be aware that to accommodate the license plate scanning system, your license plate must be visible and unobscured. If your license plate is on the rear of your vehicle, backing into a parking stall or pulling through is no longer allowed.
